Sharathon is that time of year when we pre-empt regular programming to ask you to financially support the work of Cornerstone Broadcasting. Let me throw out a few questions you should think and pray about before you make a decision to give.

Why is The Cornerstone asking me to give a donation?

We believe we share a common goal to evangelize the lost. We all share a need to have programming that allows us to grow in our Christian walk and keep us informed of the world around us from a Christian perspective. Our theme this year, which depicts our purpose, is A Lighthouse of Truth. We are a nonprofit organization. Without your support we could not exist. We are not funded by anyone but you the listener, our business sponsors, and some of the programs we air. The sharathon funds the listener portion of our budget.

How do I know The Cornerstone will use the money I give properly and for its intended purpose?

The Cornerstone is a member of the ECFA, which is the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability. We are the only radio ministry in this area that is a member. To be a member requires adherence to seven rules of accountability (see list on next page or go to www.ecfa.org). One of the rules includes a full audit. I might mention this is not a rubber stamp audit but an audit that would reveal any ir-

regularities including things like fraud, disproportionate spending on things like fundraising and salaries. This ministry is not required to be a member but desires to be a lighthouse of proper fiscal accountability to the donor and community. We want to be good stewards.


There are so many asking for my support; why should I give to your ministry?

We don't want you to give in place of your church but if you're a listener and this ministry blesses you and/or your church, you should give. This is a missionary work reaching the lost for Jesus Christ. You are doing your part to evangelize Volusia and Flagler Counties and the world through the World Wide Web when you give. We are local. 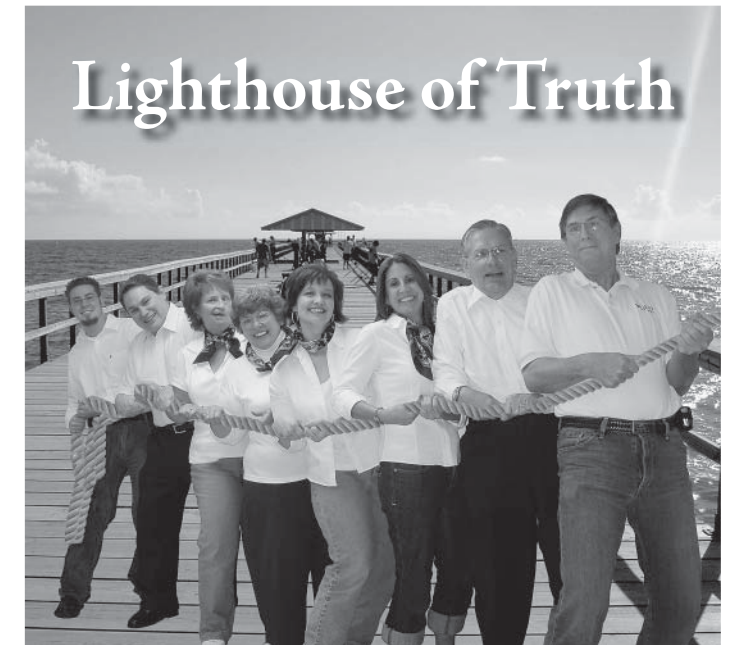
Our Commitment To You

As we ask for your commitment to us during Sharathon we want to demonstrate our commitment to you. As a member of Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability (ECFA), The Cornerstone adheres to the following seven standards of responsible stewardship:



*A higher standard
A higher purpose*

1. Doctrinal Statement- Every member shall subscribe to a written statement of faith clearly affirming our commitment to the evangelical Christian faith, and conduct our operations in a manner which reflects accepted biblical truths and practices.
2. Board Of Directors and Audit Review Committee- Every member shall be governed by a responsible board, a majority of whom shall be other than employees/staff and/ or those related by blood or marriage, which shall meet at least semi annually to establish policy and review accomplishments. The board shall appoint a functioning audit review committee, for the purpose of reviewing the annual audit and reporting its findings to the directors.
3. Audited Financial Statements- Every member shall obtain an annual audit performed by an independent certified public accounting firm in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards.
4. Use Of Resources- Every member shall exercise management and financial controls necessary to provide



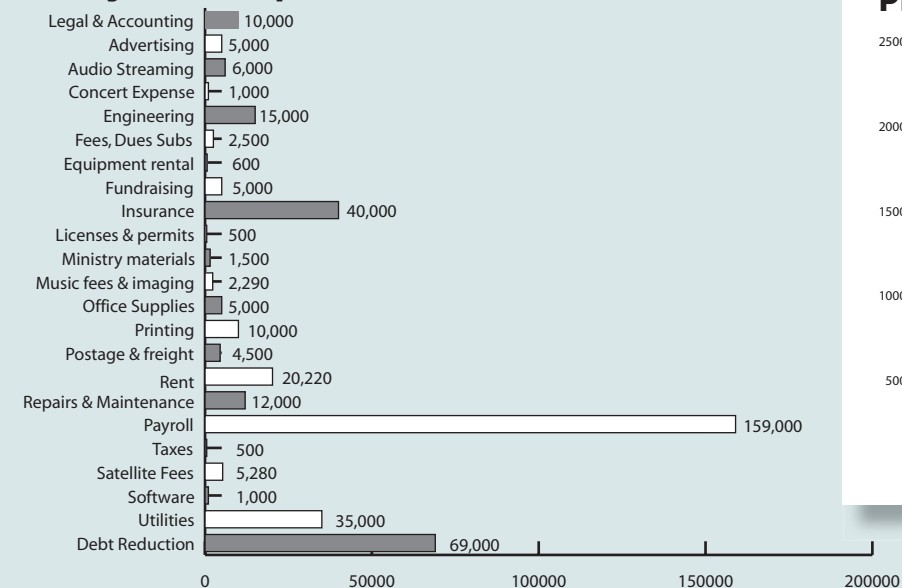

reasonable assurance that all resources are used to accomplish the exempt purposes for which they are intended.

5. Financial Disclosure- Every member shall provide a copy of its current audited financial statements upon written request.
6. Conflicts Of Interest- Every member shall avoid conflicts of interest.
7. Fund-Raising- Every member shall comply with each of the ECFA Standards for fund raising.
