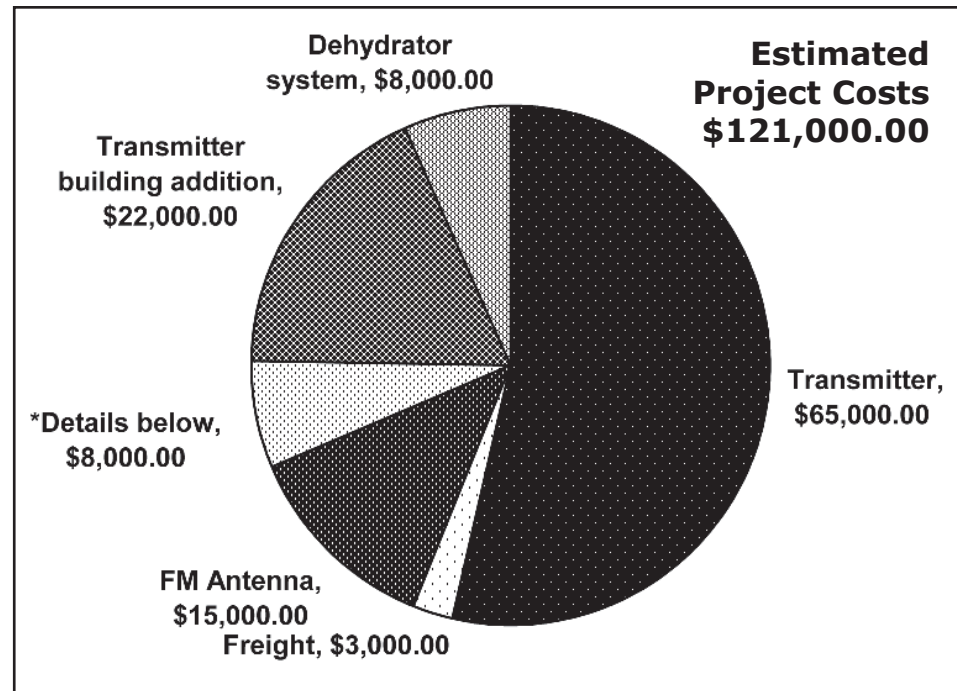

a strong footprint of the gospel been greater.

In order for Bigfoot to roam, your help is needed. Making this Bigfoot a reality will require a separate fundraiser. It will cost \$121,000 (see the breakdown on the chart). On September 24th, 25th, 26th, we will suspend regular programming to ask our listeners to partner with us to raise the funds. We are not going to do as many stations do and change our Sharathon from once a year to twice a year. **Sharathon will remain in March and continue to be our primary way of raising the operating funds.** It is not often we have this kind of opportunity that can potentially effect the eternity of so many. Stay tuned for more details throughout the month and during the Bigfoot fundraiser. Please remember this is over and above any pledges you made during Sharathon and must be kept separate. This special fundraiser will not eliminate the need for Sharathon in March.

What Is Bigfoot?

If you have listened to The Cornerstone for very long, you realize prayer is our compass. Every Thursday we pray for the needs of those who ask for prayer. We pray for one another and for those who bring the message of the gospel through the teaching programs and music this ministry provides. The Cornerstone belongs to the Lord and is not some private enterprise. You and I are the caretakers of this, God's property and collectively we leave a footprint. Together we are about our Father's business.

When the Lord called me here almost ten years ago I clearly remember that Thursday morning prayer included prayers for a bigger footprint for WJLH. This would require a power increase. If you live in Ormond, especially north, south and west of Granada then you know we have a weak signal. The northern part of Palm Coast, Daytona, Holly Hill and parts of Port Orange especially in the spring and fall have a low signal. Our current power for WJLH is 2,000 watts. In the south, WJLU has a much better signal at 10,000 watts

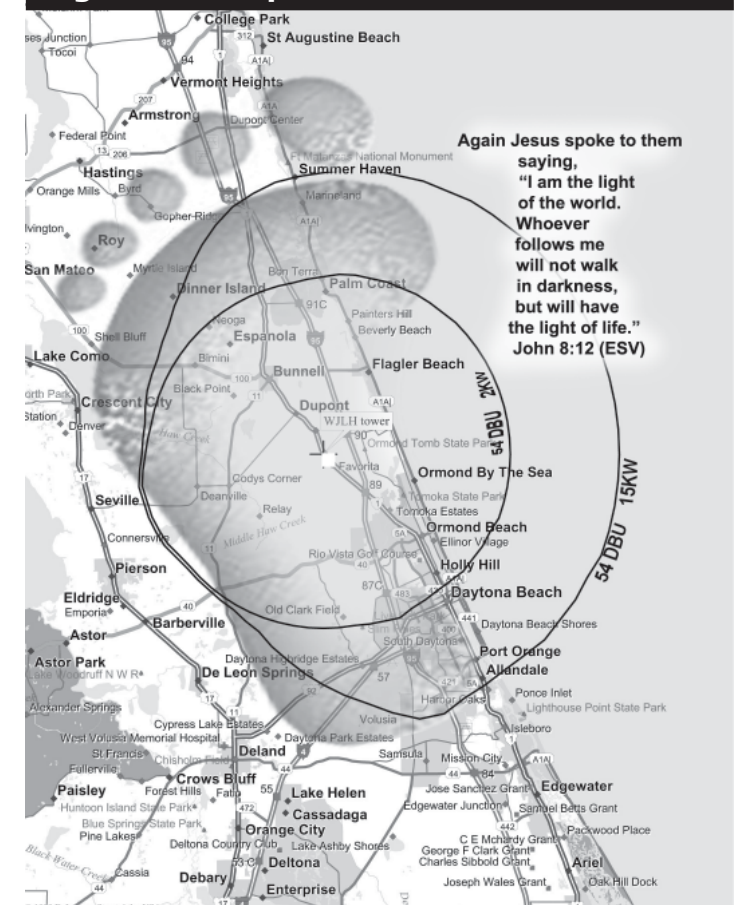
but begins to fade in Port Orange. So, the area between Port Orange and Ormond does not have the best signal. As I also said, the signal fades away in the northern part of Palm Coast.

It has been our prayer to leave a bigger foot print, so starting back in 1999 we began praying for Bigfoot and that prayer has been

answered. We have been granted a power increase from the current 2000 watts to a whopping 15,000 watts. This will give us a great signal from Marineland down to Oakhill. Yahoo! isn't God great and as always He answers our prayers not always in our timing or our way but He answers. Never before has the need for

As we step forward into getting this power increase implemented, please pray and ask God how you can be a part by supporting The Cornerstone financially so that we can reach more and more people with the solid truth through the music we play and the programs we have on the air.
